

# **NOYCE Scholarship Opportunity for Science and Math majors interested in becoming teachers**

## **What do students get?**

- **A SCHOLARSHIP! 2-years of full tuition support (plus \$ for books)** while pursuing a Teaching certificate and completion of a BS in a Science discipline or Mathematics
- Receive mentoring and peer support throughout the two years in the teacher certification program, and once they become teachers

## **Requirements for Scholarship:**

- Have declared a major in Science or Mathematics and be on track to complete this degree by the end of the two-year scholarship (“senior year”).
- Have and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- Commit to taking courses full-time to complete the teaching certification within two years (by the end of “senior year”).
- Commit to teaching for four years in a high-needs school district upon graduation.
- Admission to the College of Education: complete EDU 200 (required for acceptance into the CoE) & apply for admission to the CoE
