List of Nursing Pre-Reqs:

	ENG 112 (need placement or ENG 110 first)
	MAT 107 (need placement into or have MAT 100/P first; also, does not need to be completed before the MAT 108 requirement)
	MAT 108 (need placement into or have taken MAT 100/P w/C- or higher first; also can be taken before MAT 107; substitutions for 108 are: 112, 120, 122, 139, 150)
	PSY 100 (must take before PSY 219)
	PSY 219 (need PSY 100 first)
	PHY 103 (MAT 100P or placement into MAT 100 or higher)
	CHE 120 (MAT 100P or placement into MAT 100 or higher; must take before CHE 125)
	CHE 125 (not offered in fall; need CHE 120 first)
	BIO 200 (must take before BIO 201)
	BIO 201 (need BIO 200 first)
	BIO 120

Only 7 must be completed successfully (C+ or higher) by the February 1st application deadline.

If admitted to the program, all 11 must be completed successfully (C+ or higher) by the start of the nursing coursework. You may use the summer right before starting the nursing coursework in the fall semester to do so.

**AP exam scores of nursing prereqs must be a 4 or 5 (if you scored a 3, you must take the course for a grade of a C+ or higher)

If you do not complete all of the following before being admitted to the nursing program, you may do a couple with the nursing coursework or during intersessions.

Bachelor of Science Degree: General Information

PLEASE READ

The traditional Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program requires the completion of 120 credits – 67 credits of university requirements, nursing prerequisites, and electives; and 53 credits of upper level nursing coursework, which is limited to students formally admitted into the nursing program.

Students applying to the nursing program may be doing so at various stages within their academic journey, but traditionally speaking, students apply to the nursing program by **February 1st** of their sophomore year and if admitted, would begin the nursing program fall semester of their junior year. The degree was designed to be able to be completed within 4 years full-time (30 credits a year) – the first 2 years consisting of university requirements, nursing prerequisites, and electives; the last 2 years consisting of nursing coursework.

Nursing Application Minimum Eligibility Requirements

Application is open Nov. 1 – Feb. 1 of every year

- Must be an enrolled/accepted student at the university (SCSU), and
- Must have a minimum CUM GPA of a 3.0 (includes GPAs from all colleges attended), and
- Must have at least 7 of the 11 nursing prereqs completed successfully (C+ or higher) by the February 1st application deadline (please know that all 11 nursing prereqs must be completed successfully by the start of the nursing coursework if admitted, but only 7 are required at the time of the application), and
- Must submit the ATI TEAS 6 exam score by the February 1st deadline, and
- Must not have more than 2 grades below a C+ for any of the nursing prereqs (even if repeated for an A), and
- Must not have been dismissed from another nursing program

If you submit an application missing any of these requirements, your application will be denied with no further review. There are no exceptions.
