## $1^{\text {st }}$ Year, $2^{\text {nd }}$ Semester Course Selection:

Majors should take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: Written Communication - ENG 112: Writing Arguments
- Take ENG 120 if they are taking ENG 119 for bilingual students
- Math in sequence to T1QR: Quantitative Reasoning: Math 100/100p, MAT 103, Math 107
- The Department recommends students take two ANT courses. The Department recommends the following two courses:
- ANT 101
- ANT 102 (T2LE: Natural World II Life \& Environment)

This course is also a good option

- ANT 205 (T2TP: Time \& Place)
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses.


## Important Advising Information:

## LEP Recommended/Restricted Courses also in major or cognates:

- Students can share up to 3 courses between the LEP and their major. Courses will meet both the LEP and major/cognate requirements.
- If a course is "recommended/restricted" in a category, it will show either in the student's major and/or in cognates. It will meet both requirements.
- Students can only take two courses from a single discipline subject area in Tier 2.


## Math Requirement Information:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement. MAT 103 Math for Liberal Arts is recommended.
- If they are already taking a different math course for T1QR, they do not need to take MAT 103.

Other important information here:

- GPA of major course requirements must be 2.5 or higher
