# 1<sup>st</sup> Year, 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

• T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments or ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119.

Bilingual Students should have taken the language placement exam. They are encouraged to take the STAMP exam. They should take a language class, at their placement level.

• Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 106 (MAT 105 is a pre-requisite for MAT 106).

### Remaining courses:

 Students should take LEP Exploration courses as Well as Tech Fluency of choice from LEP Foundations. Students should pay attention to restrictions on their degree evaluation and below for suggestions

#### **Important Advising Information:**

### LEP T1/T2 Restricted/Recommended Courses: These can share with major or cognate.

- Amer Exp. or Time and place: HIS 110 or 111- US History I or II
- Creative Drive: ENG 201-Creative Writing (pre-req ENG 112)
- Conflict and Consensus or Mind and Body: SHE 203-School Health
- Conflict and Consensus or Mind and Body: EDU 200 (course will count as 1 exploration elective)
  - We recommend students take EDU 200/SED 225 1st semester, SOPHOMORE YEAR.
  - Rare exceptions for JUMPSTART Students who should take EDU200 in the spring of their Freshman year.
  - o (Note: EDU 200 requires field work and transportation to field work).

#### **DOUBLE Major:**

• Elementary Education and Elementary Bilingual pre-majors will have TWO majors; their second major is Liberal Studies. Liberal Studies is a major made up of two 18 credit concentrations. Students are automatically put into concentrations when they declare the major. For Bilingual Students the concentrations are: English and a language (ie, Spanish). For elementary education (non bilingual) the concentrations are: English and Social Science.
