Course Selection - 2nd Semester 1st Year:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112
- Math in sequence to cognate: MAT 100/MAT 100P; MAT 107
- T2GA: ENV 220-Global Climate Change (if not taken in first semester)
- ENV 204 and/or MAR 140 or ENV 200 (Major requirements)
 (Coastal and Marine Systems Concentrations SHOULD take MAR 140)

Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses. (GEO 170 for TF, GEO 200 for TP, and GEO 201 for NW PR are recommended but not required unless listed on degree evaluation in major section.)

Math Requirement Information:

• This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement, however, MAT 107-Elementary Statistics is a required cognate. MAT 107 will be able to "count" towards both the T1QR and the cognate.

ADVICE ON WHICH MATH TO TAKE:

- If a student has not yet taken a T1QR requirement, they should take MAT 107.
- If a student is already taking a different math course towards their T1QR requirement in their first semester, they will also have to take MAT 107 as a cognate. Encourage them to do so in the Spring.
