FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- Majors should take a French course at a level consistent with the placement exam results
- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 103 or 104
- LEP courses

Important Advising Information:

7-12 students, LEP T1/T2 Courses: These can share with the major or cognate.

- T1AE: HIS 110 or HIS 111 (if French 7-12)
- T2MB: SHE 203 (if French 7-12)
- T2CC: EDU 200 (if French 7-12), typically taken in sophomore year

Math Requirement Information:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement. MAT 103 or 104 recommended.
- If student is already taking a different course towards T1QR, they don't need to take MAT 103.
- Math sequence to MAT 103: MAT 100/100p to MAT 103

French 7-12 Certification:

This program has a separate admission process. Please consult the admission requirements for this program on the School of Education page for more information. Overall GPA of 2.7 is required.

Waiver Exams:

Students who are already proficient in a foreign language, are native speakers or heritage learners can waive the general education Multilingual Communication requirement by taking a waiver test ([STAMP Test](#), [ACTFL Test](#), [CLEP Exam](#)). Students can also earn as many as 9 credits of language based on the examination. Duplicate credit will not be issued for language courses that have already been completed.
