CATALOG TERM FALL 2023 FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

- T1WC: ENG 112 (ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119 – for bilingual students)
 - If completed, take any T2 course.
- T1QR: MAT 103 or MAT 107. Note: Students who are considering pursuing Nursing, Physician Assistant, or Physical Therapy programs after graduation (or any program that requires a statistics course) should choose MAT 107.
- HLS 200 Intro to Healthcare Professions and Medical Terminology (if not registered already)
- PSY 100 Intro to Psychology
- T1TF: Suggested courses include PHY 103, CSC 200

Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 (T1MC) and/or Tier 2 courses.

General Concentration:

- T2MB: PSY 100
- T2LE: BIO 200 OR BIO 100. Students considering pursuing diagnostic imaging (ultrasound), Nursing, Physician Assistant, Physical Therapy, or Physical Therapy Assistant programs should take BIO 200. SLPA students should take BIO 100.

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors who plan to apply to the nursing program SHOULD take the following (if not already taken):

- WC: English 112: Writing Arguments (ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119 – for bilingual students)
 - PSY 100 if they have taken ENG 112
 - PSY 219 (if they already have PSY 100)
- QR: MAT 107 (or MAT 100/P if needed)
 - MAT 108 if they have taken MAT 107
- BIO 200
 - BIO 201 if they already have BIO 200
 - Another nursing science prereq option can be BIO 120
- PCH 200
- Non-restricted LEP
 - Exploration electives: Although non-restricted, Nursing prereqs BIO 120 & CHE 125 will fulfill these, so students can hold off on this category for now

Important AP information: AP courses that were applied to SCSU transcripts as equivalent to nursing prerequisites will be acceptable for applying to the nursing program.
