FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 103 or 104 (recommended)
- Majors should take the following courses:
 - MUS 221 and MUS 226 (if currently enrolled in MUS 220/225)
 - T2MB: PSY 100
 - MUS 141 (if not currently taking)
 - MUS 142 (if currently enrolled in MUS 141)
 - MUS ensemble. Students can receive info about available ensembles from the MUS department chairperson.
- If any of the above already completed, then MUS 117 (T1TF)

Important Advising Information:

Math Requirement:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement. MAT 103 or 104 recommended.
- If student is already taking a different math course towards T1QR, they don't need to take MAT 103.
- Math sequence to MAT 103: MAT 100/100p then MAT 103

Co-requisites:

- MUS 220/225 and MUS 221/226 are co-requisites and may only be separated with Chair approval.
