FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119
- Majors should take at least one 200-level Philosophy course. Depending on what they're interested in, they can consider PHI 215 (Logic), PHI 220 (Ethics), PHI 207 (Religious Dimension), PHI 242 (Death and the Meaning of Life), PHI 212 (Asian Philosophy: China & Japan)
 - If Interested in Religious Studies Minor, consider PHI 207
- Math in sequence to T1QR: see note below
- LEP courses

Important Advising Information:

Math Requirement:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement, so students should take the math course that meets this requirement and their interests.
- The department chair invites students to talk with the chairperson or philosophy professor about the LEP courses, including Quantitative Reasoning that works best for each student's path through the program.
