CATALOG TERM FALL 2021 FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION.

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119 – for bilingual students
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 100/100p, MAT 107 (**MAT 107 is recommended, MAT 103 is OK**)
- One or Two Political Science courses from the following list:
 - PSC 200 – Political Change and Conflict
 - PSC 240 – Introduction to Political Thought
 - PSC 260 – U.S. Government
 - PSC 270 – International Relations
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses, paying close attention to the restrictions.

Important Advising Information:

LEP T1/T2 Restricted Courses/Recommended Courses: They can share with cognate.

Tier 2 – American Experience (select one): HIS 110 or 111

Tier 2 – Mind and Body: SHE 203

Tier 2 - Social Structure, Conflict, and Consensus: EDU 200

Tier 2 - Time and Place (select one): HIS 100 or 101

Math Requirement Information:

- MAT 100/100p, **MAT 107 is recommended! (MAT 103 is OK).**

Social Studies 7-12 Certification:

- Students should plan to take EDU 200 in their sophomore year.
- Students will need to apply to the School of Education after they take EDU 200.
- Students need a cumulative GPA of 2.7 to apply to the education program.
