CATALOG TERM FALL 2021 FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119
- Math in sequence to T1QR requirement
- Psychology Course:
 - If students did not yet take PSY 100, they should take it in spring
 - If students are in PSY 100 in the fall, they should take any PSY 200 level course (see notes below, they will need to get at least a C or higher on two PSY 200 level courses to move forward in the major).
 - Students may also take PSY 259 after completing both PSY 100 and the T1QR requirement
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses.

Important Advising Information:

LEP T1/T2 Restricted Courses/Recommended Courses: These will share with major or cognate.

- T2MB: PSY 100

Math Requirement Information:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement. Students typically take MAT 103 to meet their T1QR requirement.

List other important information here:

- Students must receive “C” or better in all classes that count towards the psychology major requirements aside from PSY 100
- To enroll into PSY 300, students must meet the following pre-requisites:
 - overall GPA of at least 2.0
 - at least 30 earned credits
 - at least two PSY courses at 200-level or higher with a grade of C or higher
- Psychology offers three concentrations (the BA General, BA Mental Health and BS) as well as two accelerated BA/MA pathway. Information about the concentrations and pathways is available on the Psychology Department website (see below)
