1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
 - ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119 – for bilingual students
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 100/100p, **MAT 107**
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses.
- If requesting PCH course, take PCH 201 Wellness in Tier 2 (Mind and Body). Recommended, but not required.
- DO NOT take PCH 202 freshman year

Important Advising Information:

LEP T1/T2 Restricted Courses/Recommended Courses: These will share with major or cognate.

Tier 1 – Quantitative Reasoning: MAT 107

Important Information:

- Two of the three required W courses are offered in the major (PCH 351 & 358)
- There is a cumulative GPA requirement of a 2.75 GPA overall and a 2.5 major GPA.
