1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 103 Math for Liberal Arts (recommended)
- Majors should take the following courses, per concentration:

Math Requirement Information:

- This major does not have a specific T1QR requirement. MAT 103 Math is recommended.
- If student is already taking a different math course towards T1QR, they don't need to take MAT 103.

Minimum Grades:

- Students must earn minimum grade of a "C" in all major courses. Courses with less than "C" must be repeated within two semesters. Students who earn a "C" or lower in more than one major course requirement may be dismissed from major.
- **B.S. Child life Specialist:** Has a 3.0 GPA to enter the program and to graduate.
- **B.S. Therapeutic Recreation:** Student must earn 2.5 overall GPA to graduate.
- **Therapeutic Recreation B.S. to M.S. Accelerated Pathway:** Student must earn 3.0 overall GPA to graduate.

- **Recreation Administration B.S. to M.S. Accelerated Pathway:** Student must earn 3.0 overall GPA to graduate.
