CATALOG TERM 2023 FIRST YEAR COURSE SELECTION

1st Year, 2nd Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments (ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119)
- Math in sequence to T1QR: any course that fulfills Quantitative Reasoning domain of LEP, no longer MAT 107
- Students may also take SWK 200: Social Welfare in America if there are spots available. (They *may* take this in the 2nd semester of their first year, but they **SHOULD** take it by the 1st semester of their second year. So if they don't get it into a section in the spring, they should plan to take it in the fall of sophomore year.) It will also be offered in the summer sessions.
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 and Tier 2 courses.
 - Note, students should be aware that there are LEP courses that can also be cognate course for SWK. See list below.

Cognate/Minor Information

- Social Work students have the option of selecting a minor OR completing cognate courses. Both consist of 18 credits (six courses). Cognates can now be used to fulfill LEP requirements, so if a student wishes to take a cognate, we recommend that they choose a cognate that also fulfills a LEP requirement (to minimize electives if they change major).
- A cognate course is any course from SOC, ANT, PSY, PCH, WGS or other classes that are related to Social Work. Please have students visit the Social Work <u>website</u> or their degree evaluation for a specific list of classes.
- The following courses are examples of cognates that also fulfill a LEP requirement: WGS 150 (T1TF); REC 120 (T2MB); PSY 100 (T2MB);

Information about Applying to the Major

- Students usually apply to the Social Work program in the <u>second semester of their sophomore year</u>. In order to be eligible to apply, students must complete:
 - o SWK 200 with a B- or better
 - o ENG 112
 - have earned at least 57 credits
 - have at least **2.50** or higher GPA
