## 1<sup>st</sup> Year, 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester Course Selection:

Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
  - o ENG 120 if they have taken ENG 119 for bilingual students
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 100/100p, MAT 103 (or higher)
  - Note, the department suggests MAT 107 for the T1QR requirement, though it is not required.
- Students should take SOC 100: Introduction to Sociology
- Criminology students should take SOC 162: Introduction to Criminology as well as SOC 100
- Remaining courses: Students should take LEP Tier 1 & Tier 2 courses.
