Pre-Majors SHOULD take the following courses (if not already taken):

- T1WC: English 112: Writing Arguments
- Math in sequence to T1QR: MAT 106
- MAT 105 is a pre-requisite for MAT 106
- PSY 100

Remaining courses:
Students should take LEP Exploration courses as Well as Tech Fluency of choice from LEP Foundations. Students should pay attention to restrictions on their degree evaluation and below for suggestions

## Important Advising Information:

LEP Explorations Restricted/Recommended Courses/Recommended Courses: These courses are shared in cognates.

- Amer Exp. or Time and place: HIS 110 or 111- US History I or II
- Conflict and Consensus or Mind and Body: SHE 203-School Health
- Conflict and Consensus or Mind and Body: EDU 200 (typically taken Fall/first semester sophomore year) (Course will also count as 1 Exploration Elective)
- (Please note EDU 200 involves Field work and transportation to field work)
