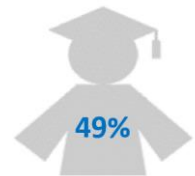

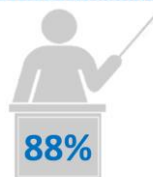
## Official Graduation Rate 6-Year (Fall 2011 Cohort)
