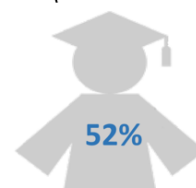

Official Graduation Rate

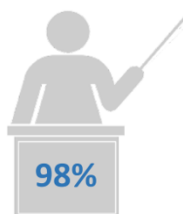
6-Year (Fall 2013 Cohort)
