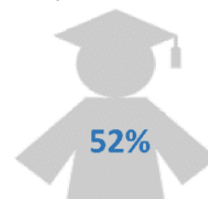

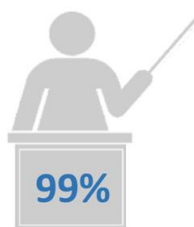
## Official Graduation Rate 6-Year (Fall 2015 Cohort)
