Message from the Director of Orientation, Transition & Family Engagement

Dear Parents and Families,

We hope this email finds you well! As April begins next week, we will enter the last six weeks of the semester. This is a time where our campus will be filled with so many activities and celebrations! This Saturday, April 1st will be <u>Accepted Students Day</u>. Many of you may remember attending this event as your students were exploring their options and making the very important decision of which institution they would attend. While it may have been a few years back for some, we want to thank you for choosing Southern and continuing to do so. If you, or someone you know, has students who may be coming to Southern or are still contemplating their college choice, please encourage them to attend Saturday's event.

For many students, this is an incredibly important point in the semester. Mid-term grades have been posted. Students can access their mid-term grades via Bannerweb (https://inside.southernct.edu/advising/resources/videos). Please know that mid-term grades are NOT calculated in any way in a student's final grade. They should consider their mid-term grade as a benchmark, or snapshot, of their academic progress thus far in the semester. If a student has questions about their mid-term grade, they should connect with their professor. As students evaluate their performance, they could utilize several resources in developing a plan in pursuing their academic goals. In addition to connecting with their professors, they could seek academic support for both the content of their courses and guidance in improving their overall skills as a college student at the Center of Academic Success and Accessibility Services (https://inside.southernct.edu/casas). If a student determines that they may not be successful in a course, they can withdraw from a course before Tuesday, April 11th (https://inside.southernct.edu/onestop/withdrawal). Please encourage your students to connect with their advisor if they are considering withdrawing from a course.

Below, you'll see the upcoming fall 2023 course registration dates. Students should be meeting with their advisors over the next few weeks in preparation to register for their fall courses.

Do not delay in scheduling an Academic Advising Appointment (for undergraduate students):

Academic advising procedures differ depending on your major and class, ranging from group advising sessions to individual meetings. You will receive an email from your major department or advisor explaining their procedure.

- If you are a freshman in your first semester, you will meet individually with your INQ instructor for course registration advising and to receive your registration PIN number.
- If you are a second-semester freshman, sophomore, junior or senior, you should follow the academic advising procedure detailed by major department or advisor for course registration advising and to receive your registration PIN number.
- If you have been not contacted by your advisor/department (<u>Who is my advisor?</u>), please contact your advisor or the department chairperson for your major directly.

Dear Members of the Class of 2023:

If you are receiving this email, you are eligible to walk in Southern's 2023 Undergraduate Commencement ceremony on Friday, May 19 at the Total Mortgage (formerly Webster Bank) Arena in Bridgeport, beginning with an academic procession at 10:15 a.m.

Eligibility to Walk

Undergraduates eligible to participate in commencement include those who graduated in the most recently completed fall 2022 or winter 2022-23 term, and students with at least 100 credits (including in-progress) who will be completing all remaining requirements in the spring 2023 or summer 2023 term. While Commencement is a ceremony to recognize recent and upcoming graduates in the 2022-23 academic year, it is not confirmation of graduation from your program and diplomas are not issued at the event. Visit One Stop > Graduation to learn more about graduation requirements and diplomas.

Commencement Registration

Later this week, you will receive an email from commencement@southernct.edu and will be asked to create an account through our partner vendor, Marching Orders. Once that is done, you will be able to choose and distribute guest tickets, confirm your information for the reader card required for commencement day and record your name so that it's pronounced correctly at the

ceremony. Reader cards will be distributed on Tuesday, May 2 and Wednesday May 3 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at the Lyman Center Lobby. Graduates must have their reader card with them to walk at commencement, so please make every effort to pick your card up on one of these two days.

Guest Tickets

Each candidate may choose up to four digital guest tickets, which may be distributed via email or printed out. Your guests may use either the printed ticket or the mobile version. Each individual ticket is unique, so tickets may not be shared with multiple guests. If there are remaining tickets after the first allocation, they will be distributed at a later date.

Class of 2023 Senior Celebration

Caps and Gowns

Candidates for the bachelor's degree must purchase a cap and gown at the university bookstore in order to participate in the ceremony. Caps, gowns and tassels will be available in person starting Monday, April 3 at a cost of \$52 plus tax. Students who wish to have their regalia shipped home may make arrangements to do so when they make their purchase at the bookstore. Caps and gowns will also be available for purchase during reader card distribution at the Lyman Center (9 a.m. to 3 p.m. May 2 and 3).
