

Adding Classes

Students can add classes during the first week of the semester. If they miss this deadline, they may submit a Late Add Appeal during the second week. *New Form!* A streamlined Late Add Appeal webform has replaced the old PDF, with automated prompts for instructor and chairperson approval sent to their campus email. Deans are no longer required to review these requests.

Dropping Classes

New! Students now have a two-week window to drop a class without it appearing on their transcript or affecting their GPA. Note that <u>refund deadlines</u> remain unchanged; students must drop or withdraw by the refund deadlines to receive a refund for tuition and fees. After this period, students may still withdraw with a 'W' on their transcript until the withdrawal deadline.

New Webform System for Instructors and Chairpersons

This system features web form capabilities, streamlined workflows, and automated communications. Submissions are routed directly to our office for processing and storage in the student's official record. To assist with this transition, we have developed the following training videos:

• OnBase Web Forms: Instructor Tutorial (2m44s)

The Audit Contract is the first form requiring Instructor approval, allowing students to request a course audit (attending the course without receiving a grade or credit).

• OnBase Web Forms: Chairperson Tutorial (4m42s)

The Late Add Appeal is the first form requiring both Instructor and Chair approval, used by students to request a late addition to their schedule during the week following the regular add period.


