

- Career development





This is an important notice about your education record and your rights as a student. Southern Connecticut State University is committed to protecting your education records under the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA). For full details on our FERPA policy, please visit the <u>Student Records website</u> and look for the FERPA section.

As an annual reminder, you have the following rights regarding your education records:

• Inspect and review your education records.

- Request an amendment to your education records.
- **Request that your directory information** be withheld from public disclosure.

If you wish to withhold your directory information from public disclosure, please visit the <u>Student Records website</u> and find the Directory Information section for the full policy and request form.


Additionally, you can authorize the release of your student record information to a parent, guardian, or other third party. To do this:

- Log into <u>Banner Student</u>.
- Go to Records and Registration.
- Select Authorization to Release Records (if viewing on a cell phone, check Additional Links).
- Click Add a New Designee.
- Select Financial, Academic, or Both types of information.
- Set a 4-digit Authorization Code (this code will be required by the designee to discuss your records).
- Enter Parent/Guardian/Third Party Information.
- Save.

You can revoke access at any time by following the same steps.




