Suggested Semester Tasks for Undergraduate Assigned Advisors

Start of the Semester

Welcome advisees to the Spring Semester

Send a WELCOME BACK EMAIL:

- See your list of your advisees and consider sending them a welcome back email. [How-To Video](#)
- Share with your advisees your Faculty Office Hours and how they can contact you. We suggest using the "Faculty Office Hours" feature in Navigate as an easy way students can make appointments with you (virtual or in person). [How-To Video](#) or [How-To PDF](#)
- Refer students to the [Academic Advising Centers](#) for additional advising support.
- Encourage students to use tutoring and other resources at [CASAS](#).
- Tell students about the [ONESTOP](#) link with information and [LiveChat](#) for all student-facing offices.
- Remind students to apply to the [SCSU Foundation-Based Scholarships](#) due 2/15.

Week of Feb. 24

Communicate about March Advising Meetings

COMMUNICATE about March advising appointments:

- The week of February 24th - before the "March advising season" begins - email your advisees about how to make an advising appointment and explain your expectations for how they should prepare for the meeting. We ask that you communicate with your advisees by March 1.
- We recommend using [Navigate Appointment Campaigns](#) or [Faculty Office Hours](#) as an efficient way to book appointments.
- Encourage students to use the course schedule available on 3/02 in [Schedule Planner](#), [Catalogs and Maps](#) and any department specific tools to prepare for the meeting.

Academic Advising Appointments

Hold ADVISING MEETINGS:

- All students need to meet with their assigned advisor to discuss their program of study, course registration and receive their registration pin.
- Registration Pins and the course schedule will be available on March 2.
- Assigned advisors should use Navigate to leave an [Advising Appointment Notes/Reports](#). You can also see notes left by others in Navigate.
- If you have concerns about your advisee, use Navigate to [Issue an Alert](#).
- You can refer students to the [Academic Advising Centers](#) for additional advising support.

Month of April

Priority Registration Dates 4/4-4/25

PRIORITY REGISTRATION Period:

- Refer students to the [Academic Advising Centers](#) for additional advising support.
- Point students to [Registration Checklist](#), where they can use a new tool that gives each student their exact registration date/time.
- Encourage students to use [Schedule Planner](#) as a powerful tool for course registration.
- The Academic Advising Department communicates with and offers support to students who don't register on their priority date.

Communicate with Advisees

GIVE contact information for summer-break:

- Send an email to continuing advisees letting them know if/how they can contact you over the summer and that they can use the [Academic Advising Centers](#) for additional advising support.
- If you will not be answering emails regularly over summer, leave an out-of-office message directing students with questions about the Major to your chair/coordinator and with general advising questions to the [Academic Advising Centers](#).
