In-Person Callbacks

Callback List will be announced on January 31st. If your name appears on the list, plan to attend:

February 1st at 7:00 p.m. Lyman Center Mainstage

You must submit a video recorded audition to be considered for a role. If you are unable to do so and wish to be considered for the musical, contact Professor Nye to make other arrangements.

Prepare a song from a musical to sing. Record yourself singing 32 bars only of the music. (Recording may be with or without accompaniment.) Do not record and send the entire song, so choose the best part of the music that highlights your talents. If you can hit the "money note", sing that portion of the song. If you cannot hit the "money note", do not sing that portion of the song. Everyone must sing to audition for the musical.

An accompanist will be provided for the callbacks. Everyone must sing at the callbacks. You will be informed if you need to bring any sheet music to the callbacks. The cast list will be announced by February 2^{nd} with rehearsals beginning that evening.
