Updates

1. Digital evaluation files

Procedure for faculty undergoing digital evaluation during 2019-2020

Procedure for faculty *not* undergoing digital evaluation during 2019-2020

Templates in Blackboard Courses were rolled out by at the end of the fall semester. All faculty not undergoing digital evaluation during 2019-2020 now have a course listed in Blackboard 9 titled, Last Name, First Name - Digital Evaluation. This course contains 9 folders which are available for you to upload documents for all evaluation files; Renewal, Professional Review, Promotion, and Tenure. - 2. Faculty Survey on Administrative Effectiveness The responses from this survey, administered in spring 2019, have been calculated and will be presented at the 2/12/20 meeting
- 3. Ad hoc 2+2 Committee An ad hoc Faculty Senate committee has been constituted to explore 2+2 programs on the campuses of community colleges which would serve as SCSU satellite campuses. These programs would enable students to complete a Bachelor's Degree at the site of the CC with the first two years resulting in an Associate's Degree from the CC and the second two years resulting in a Bachelor's Degree from Southern. The charge of the committee is to consider the feasibility, cost-benefits, logistics, interest level, etc. in the development of such programs. The committee is comprised of a combination of Senators and others outside of the Senate and is chaired by Senators Cook and Wharton. The committee will meet during the FS Standing committee time. The committee's regular reports will appear in the Senate packet.
- 4. Newer Faculty Workshop Ad hoc Senate Committee An ad hoc Senate committee has been formed by the Executive Committee that will plan a workshop for newer (up to year 5) faculty to take place this semester. The goal of the workshop is to provide information to faculty

regarding topics such as the faculty review process, funding opportunities, University structure and committees, AAUP, etc. There will also be an opportunity for the exchange of ideas, conversations, and time for open-ended questions and answers. The committee will be comprised of faculty from various career stages. Meetings will take place at a time mutually agreeable to the committee members. The committee's regular reports will appear in the Senate packet.

5. Digital Measures licensing - IT is in conversations with Watermark regarding Digital Measures licensing that will include all the non-teaching faculty. There should be a resolution on this soon.
