## SCSU Faculty Senate President's Report – March 30, 2022 meeting

## **Preparation for meeting**

#### I. Resolutions and other business

There are two resolutions for this meeting:

- Resolution Regarding Latin Honors, from the Elections Committee The intent of this resolution is to provide a more equal footing to transfer students in the awarding of Latin Honors. The lowering of the number of in-house credits to 45 will put us more in line with other facilities and enable high-performing transfer students to receive this recognition.
- 2) Resolution Regarding COVID from the Executive Committee Given the possibility or even likelihood of a resurgence of COVID in the fall, the EC is bringing this resolution to the Senate in order to advocate that faculty be involved in these discussions and decisions since this has not taken place consistently at the university or system levels.
