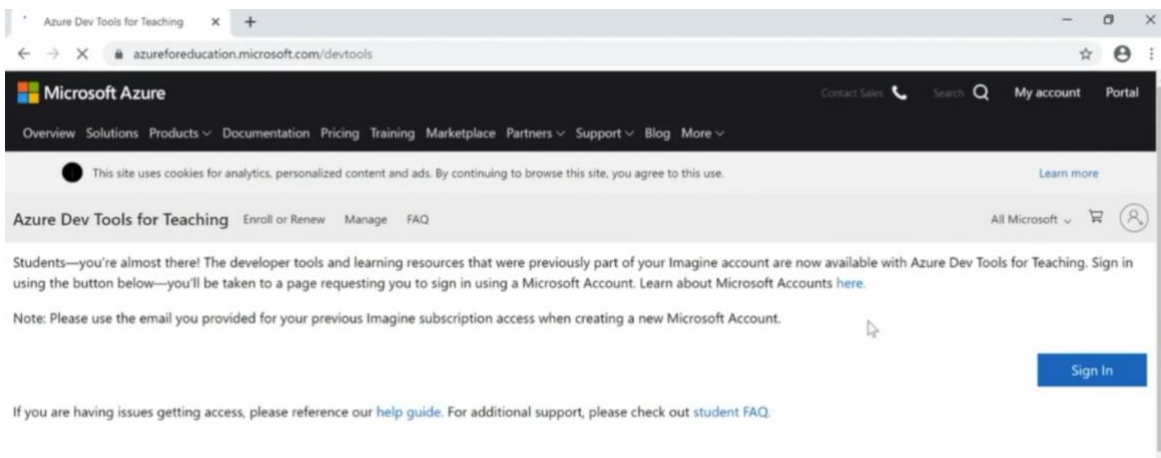

Introduction

Microsoft Azure Dev Tools for Education provides a no cost option that allows students, faculty, and staff to install Microsoft software on personal devices for instructional purposes.

Installation

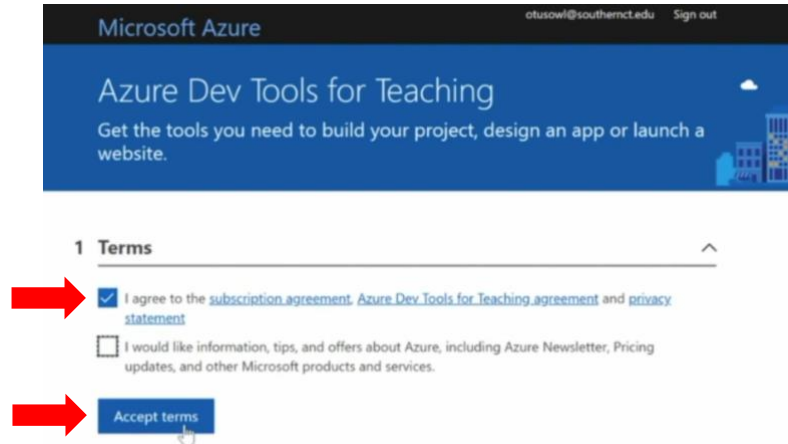
1. Go to: <http://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools>
2. Select "Sign In".



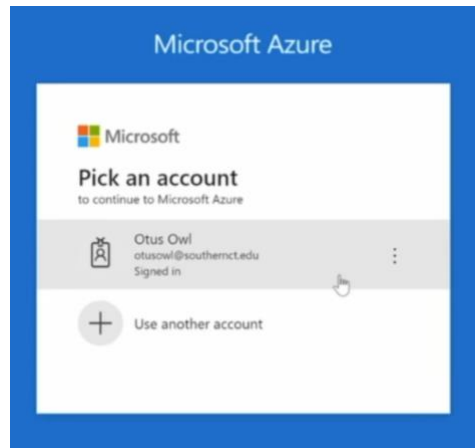
3. Sign in with your full SCSU email address and password, and authenticate your account.



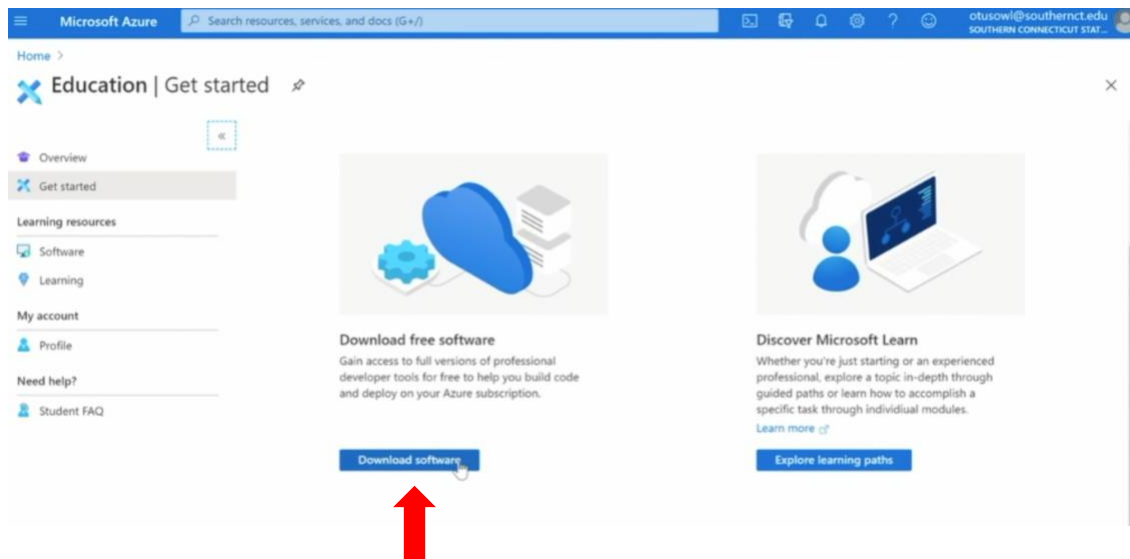
4. Review the terms of service, select the checkbox to agree, and select “Accept terms”.



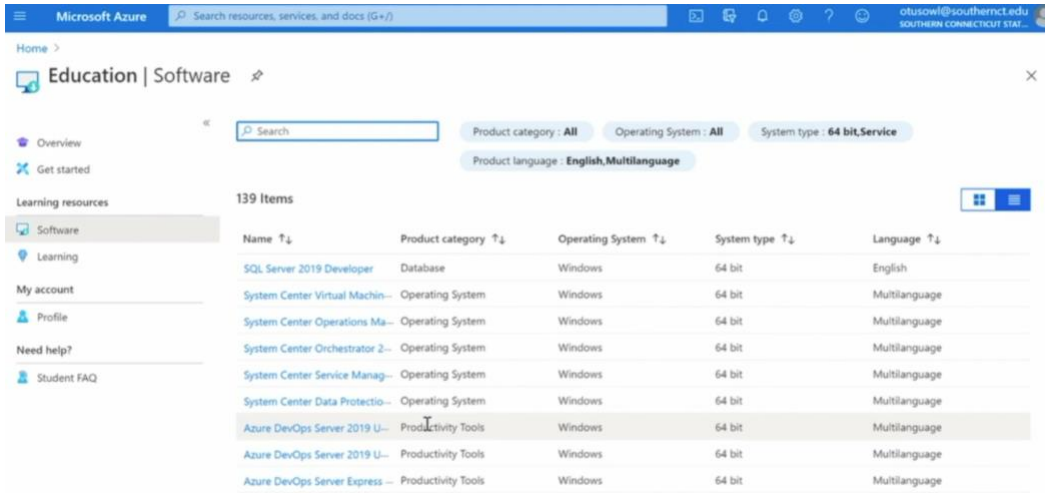
5. Select your account if shown or log in once more.



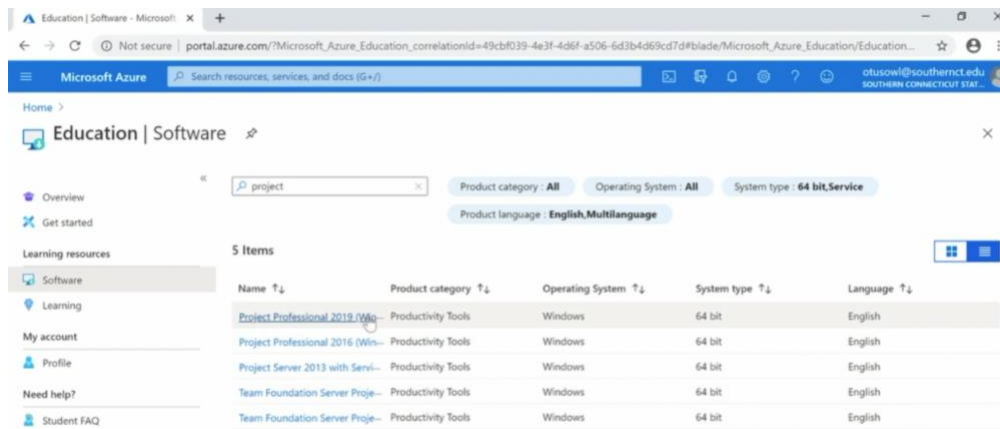
6. Scroll down and select “Download software”.



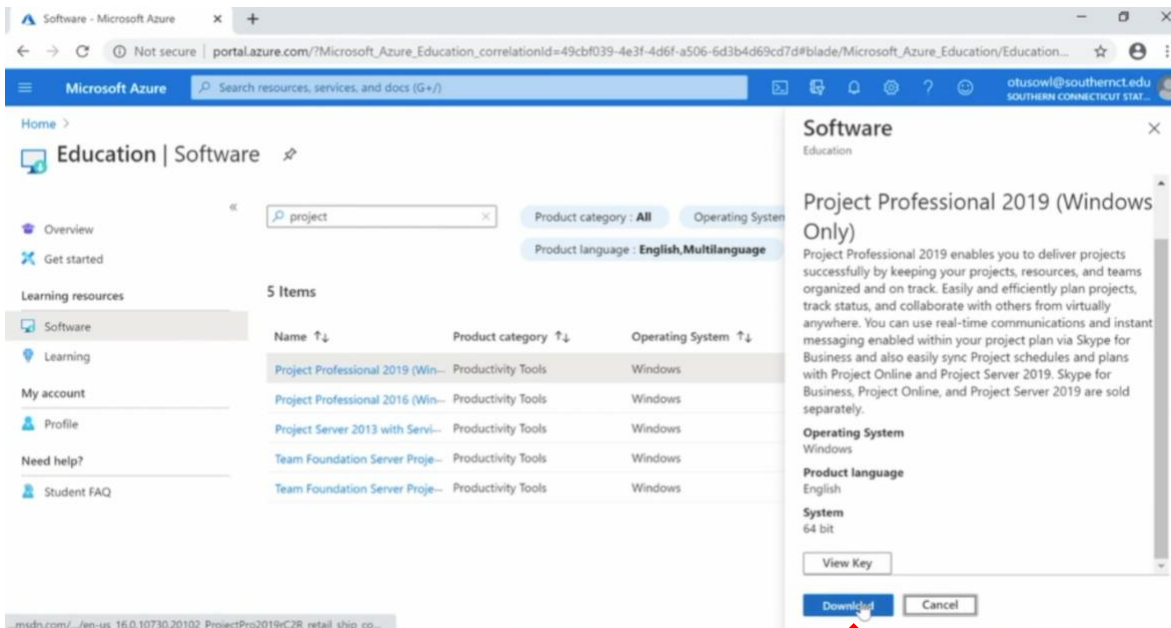
7. Scroll to explore the full list of available downloads or use the search bar to look for a specific item. See the next section which lists some popular software available here. We will be using Microsoft Project 2019 as an example of a download and install.



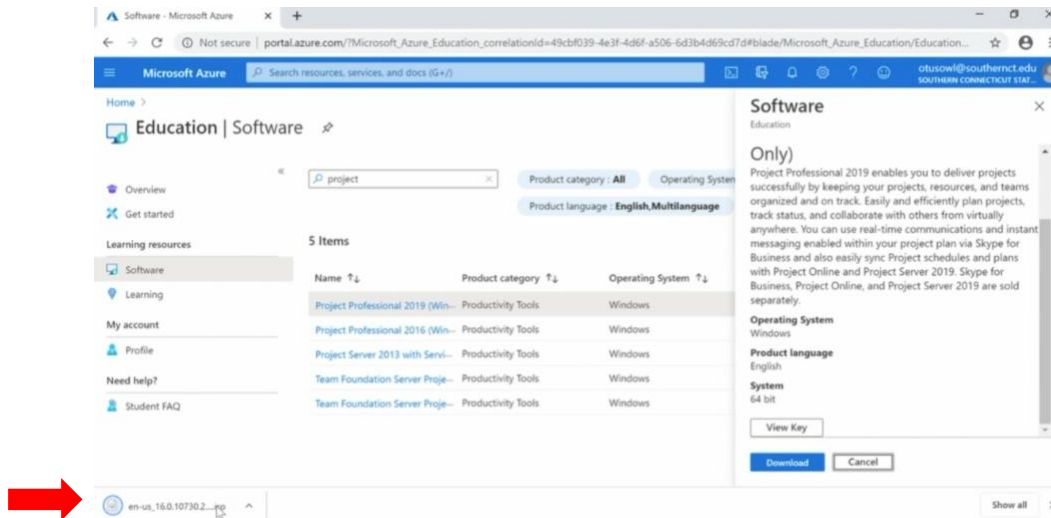
8. Select the desired software.



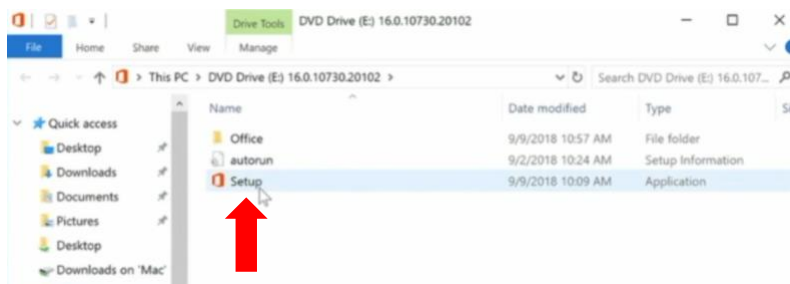
9. Select "Download" from the right-hand windows that appears.



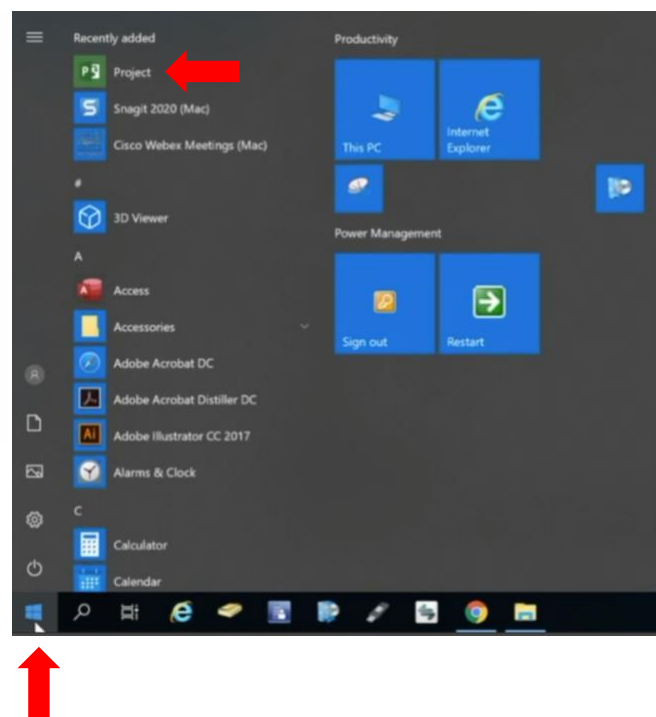
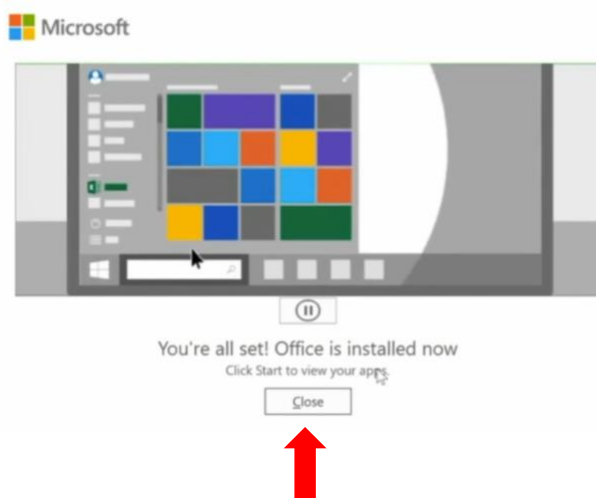
10. Open the file when finished downloading.



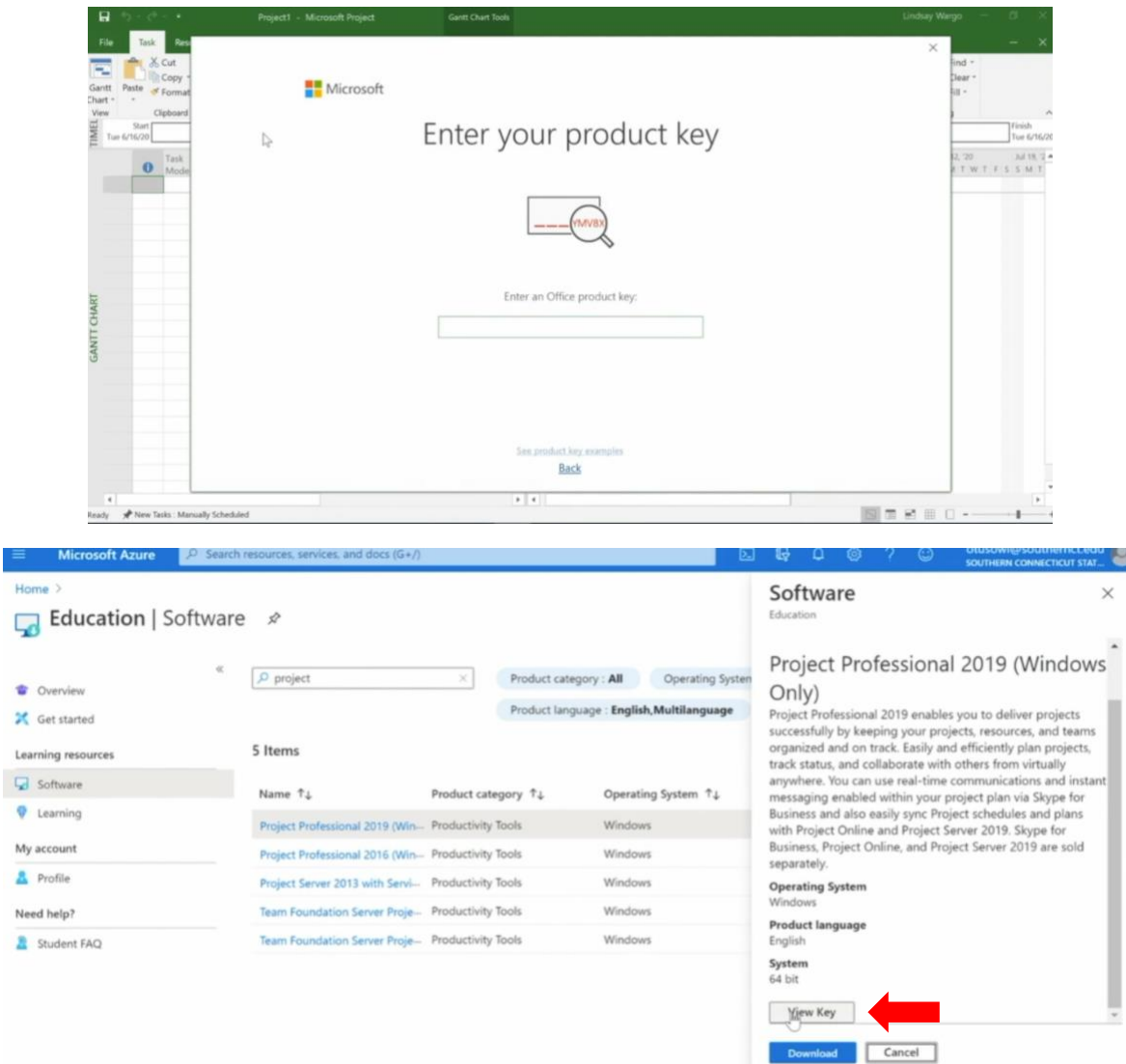
11. Some software may auto-download and run the installer package. Here, we will need to select the installer titled "Setup".



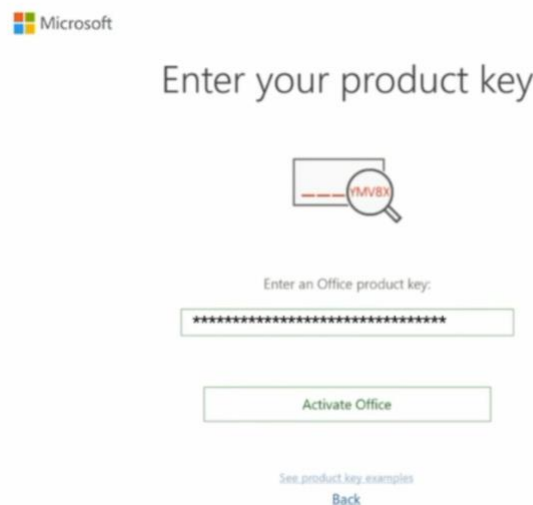
12. Once finished installing, close the window and select the Start Menu to find and open the newly installed software.



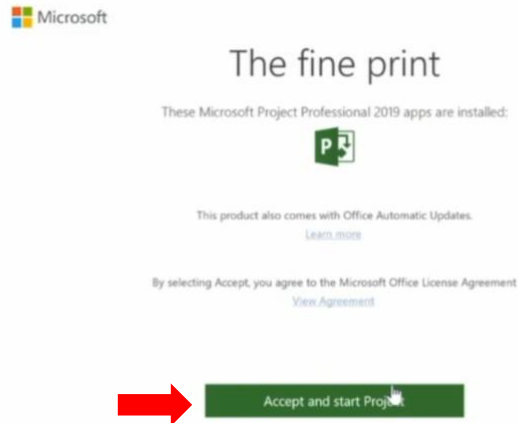
13. Some software may require a product key to begin using. This can be found on the download website.



14. Select “View Key”, then simply copy and paste the code and select “Activate Office”.



15. Accept any additional agreements after reviewing, and your software will be ready to use!
