Introduction

One way to avoid Keychain issues on a Mac is to reset your SCSU NetID password directly through your university-issued Mac's settings. The following steps will walk you through how to change your password this way.

Changing password

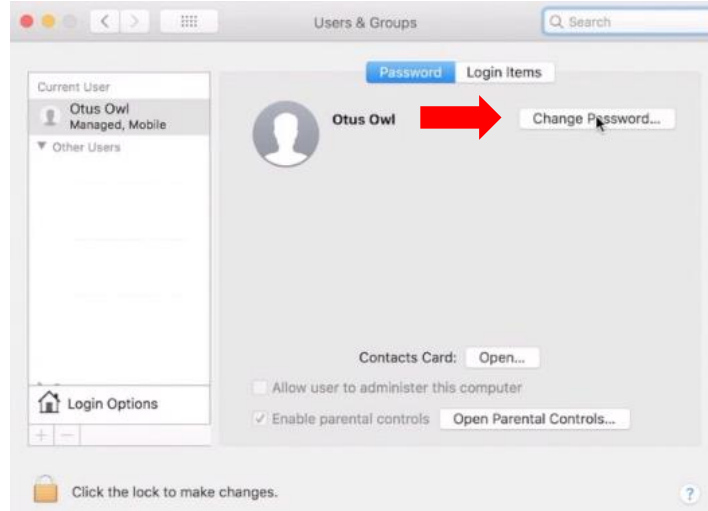
1. Begin by insuring you are connected to Southern's network via the "SSL" wireless network, and ethernet cable, or the GlobalProtect VPN working remotely, off-campus.
2. Select the Apple symbol from the top toolbar, then open "System Preferences".



3. Select "Users & Groups".



4. Select “Change Password”.



5. Enter your old (current) password, new password, and add a hint for your password if you wish. Once finished, click “Change Password” to register the change.

Password requirements:

- At least 8 characters total
- At least 1 lower-case letter
- At least 1 upper-case letter
- At least 1 symbol
- Is not one of your last 6 passwords
- Does not contain any personal information (i.e., name, birthdate)
