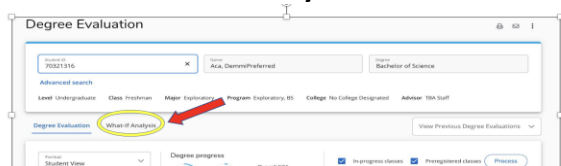


Running a What-If Analysis for New Catalog Year

Are you thinking of changing your Catalog Term to take advantage of the LEP revision? You can use a What-If Analysis to see how the new LEP will impact your course requirements

To run a What-If Analysis:

1. Open your **Degree Evaluation** via: My Apps_BannerStudent_Records and Registration_Degree Evaluation.
2. **Select the What-If Analysis** under between the first two boxes:



3. This will take you to a new screen and select options in the following fields:

- **Catalog Year field** - select Fall 2023 (which is the Catalog Term when the newly revised LEP will be in effect)
 - **Program field** - select your CURRENT MAJOR (pay attention to be sure you pick the correct one). This will then automatically fill the Level and Degree fields.
 - **Concentration field** - select your CURRENT CONCENTRATION (if you have one).
 - **Minor field** - select a minor if you are currently in one.
4. Click the **PROCESS** in the right corner of the box .
 5. This will generate a “What-If” Degree Evaluation, with your Fall 2023 catalog Year/Term program.
