Introduction

This guide will show how to connect Windows devices to the Wi-Fi network: Eduroam.

How to connect

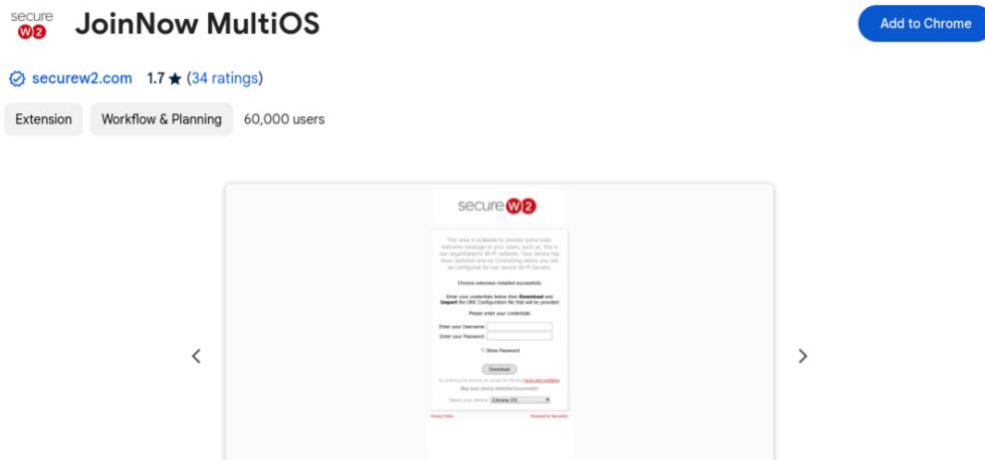
1. Open a browser and enter the URL: eduroam.southernct.edu
 - a. You will be directed to the SCSU Eduroam landing page where your device's system will be detected.



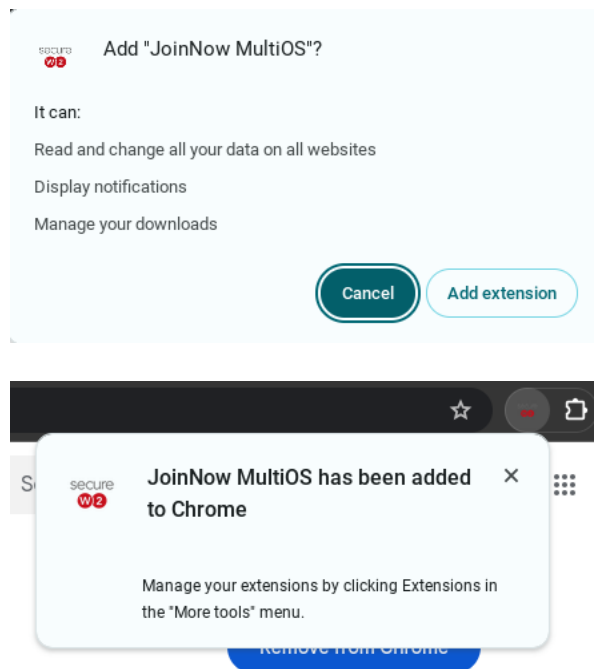

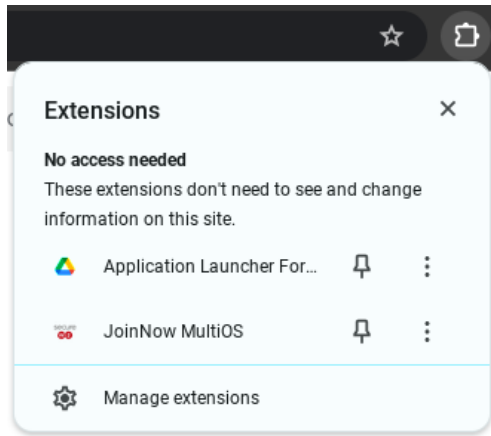
- b. If your device is detected incorrectly, select the correct type below.
- c. When confirmed, click “Install”.

2. A new tab with a prompt to add the “securew2” extension to Chrome will appear. Click “Add to Chrome”.

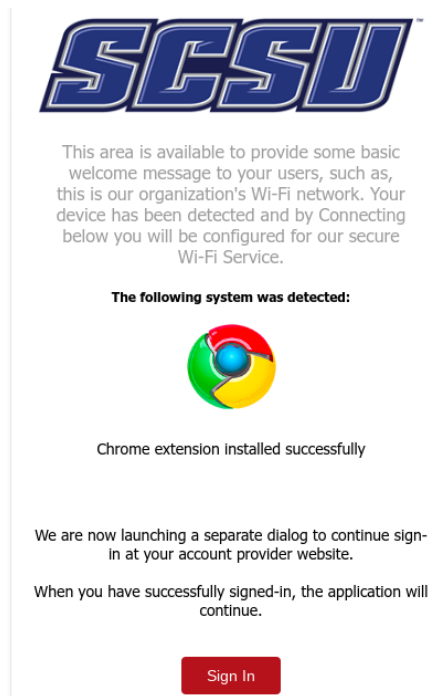


- a. Click “Add extension”. Once done, a notification will be shown on the top right of your browser and the new extension will be pinned.

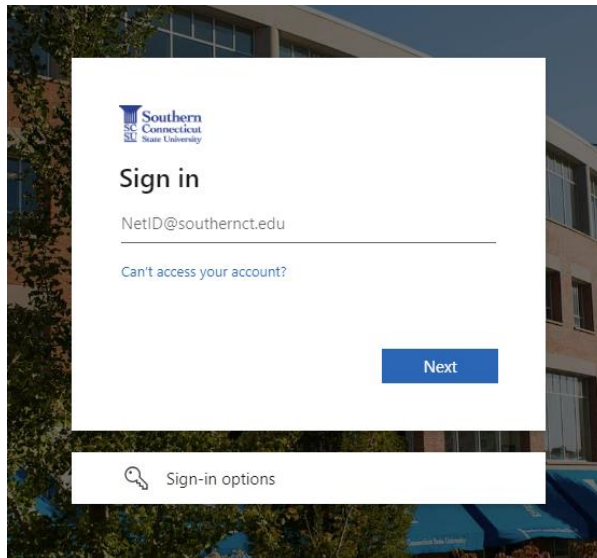




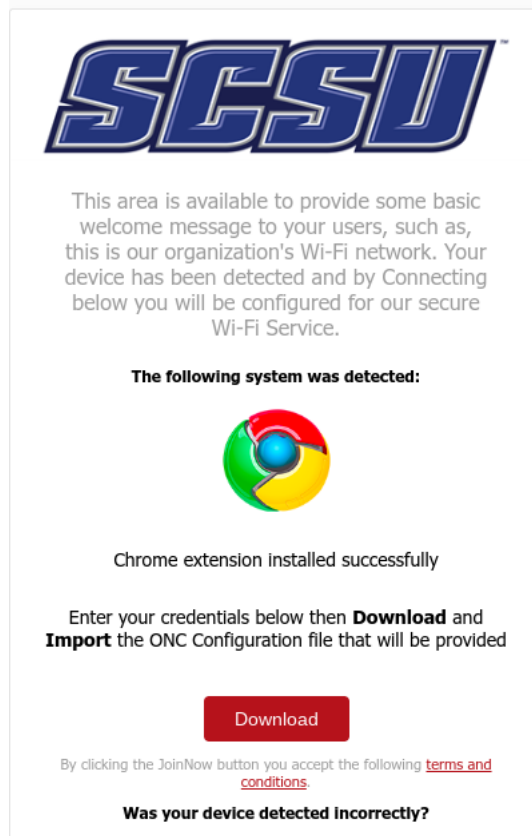
3. Once the extension is installed, navigate back to the landing page tab. The prompt should read "Chrome extension installed successfully". Click "Sign In" to authenticate your credentials.



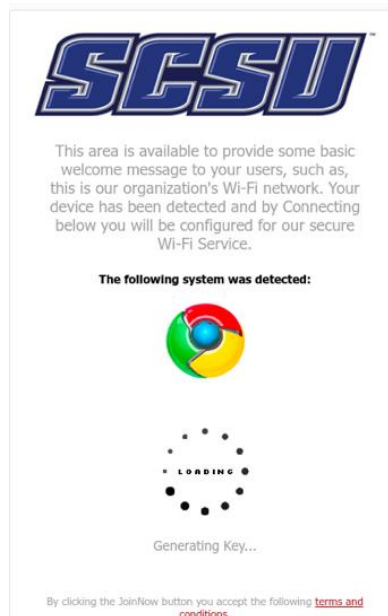
- a. Enter your full SCSU email address and password.



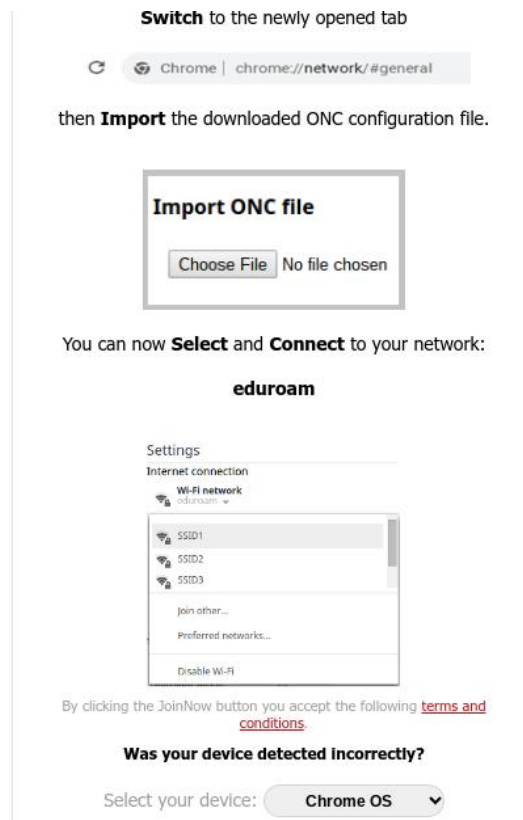
4. After authenticating your credentials, the system will prompt the Download and Import of the ONC Configuration file. Click “**Download**”.



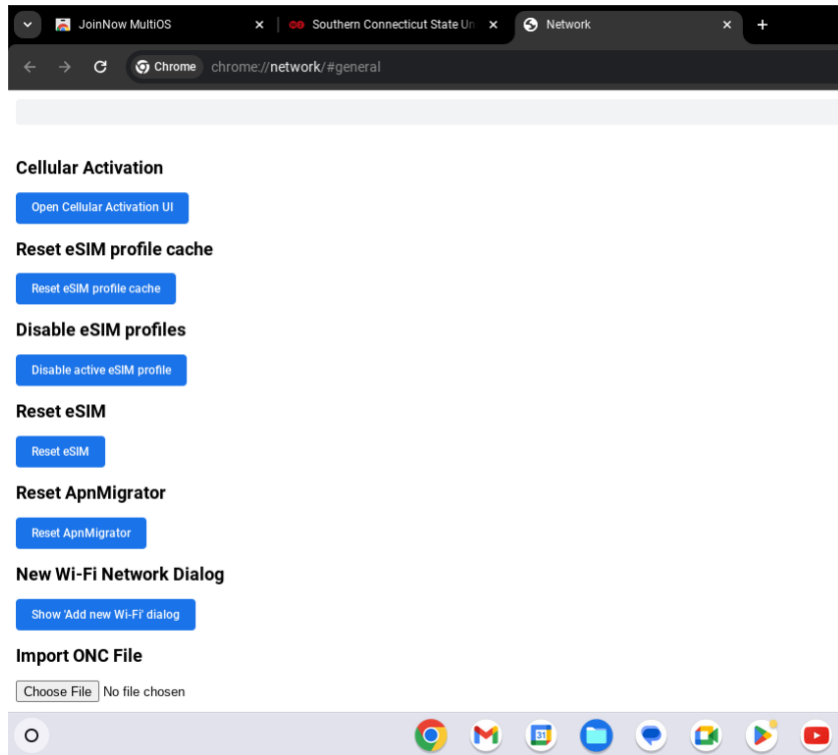
- a. The status will show as “Generating Key...”



b. Once finished, a prompt will display the next steps to the connection process.



c. A new tab will appear with the title, "Network". Once selected, scroll to the bottom of the page to the section labeled "Import ONC File" and select "Choose File".



Import ONC File

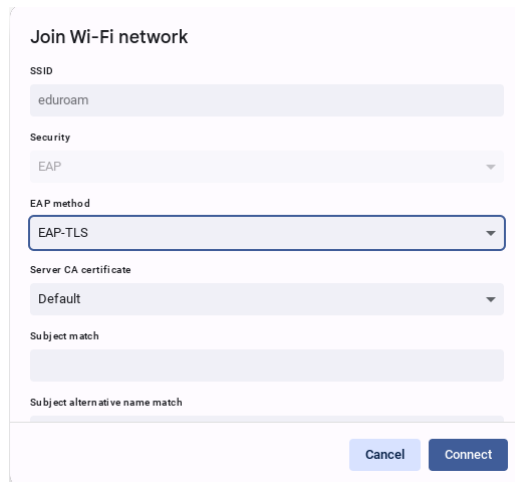

- d. Choose the configuration file titled, "SecureW2" and select "Open".



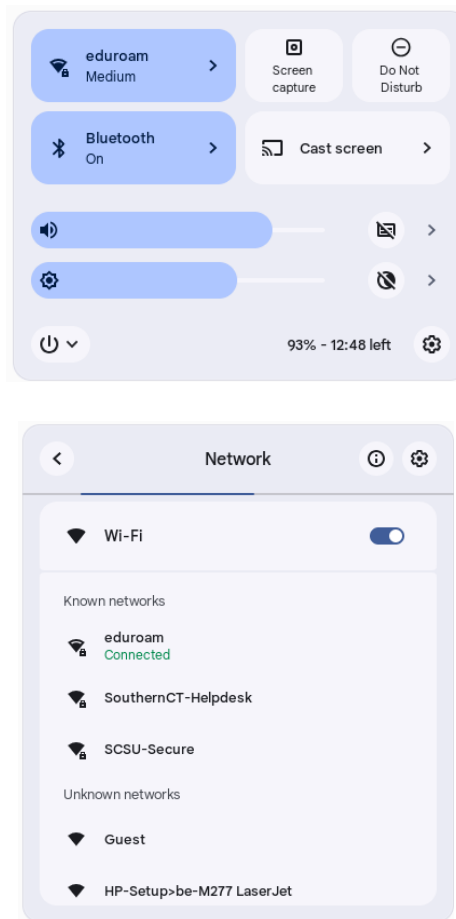
- e. Once the import is successful, navigate to the network icon located in the bottom left and select "eduroam". A prompt will appear to "Join Wi-Fi network".



f. Click “Connect”.
