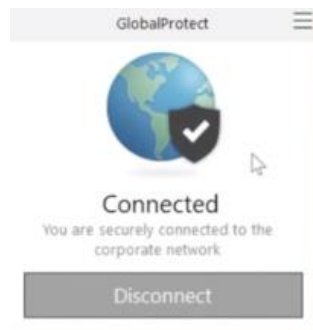
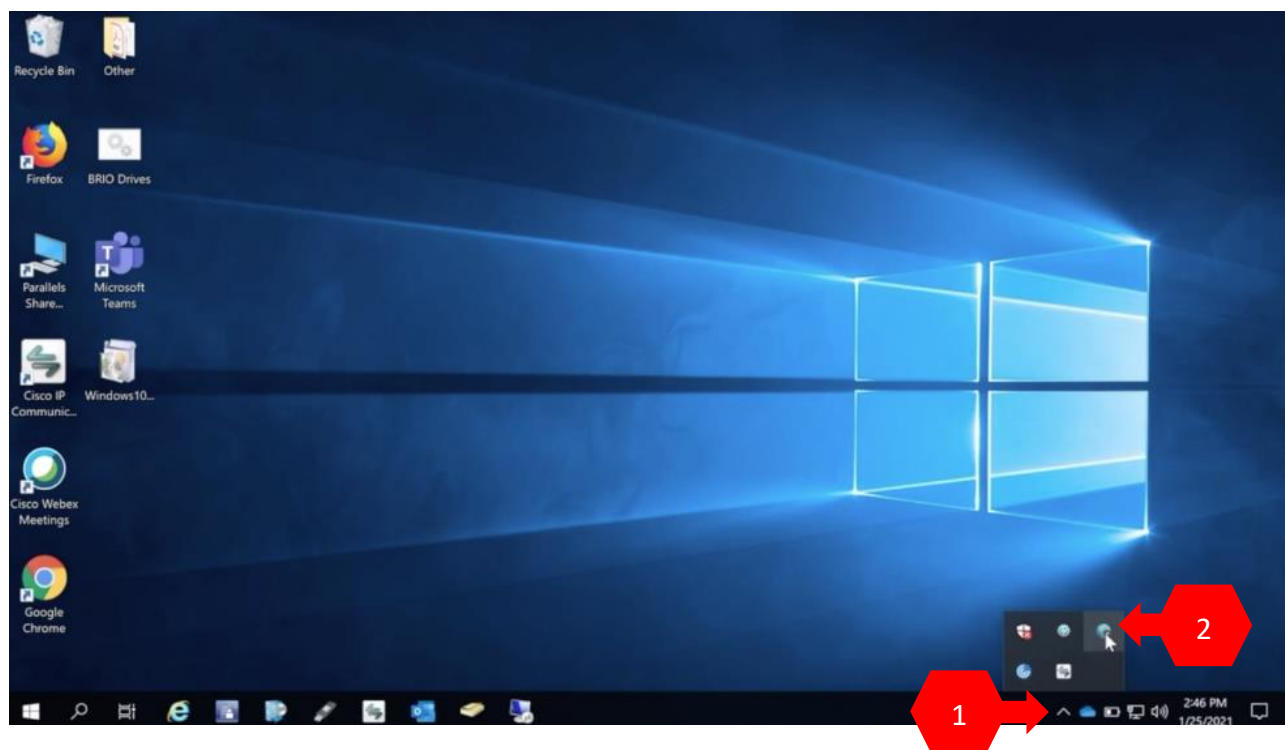

### Introduction

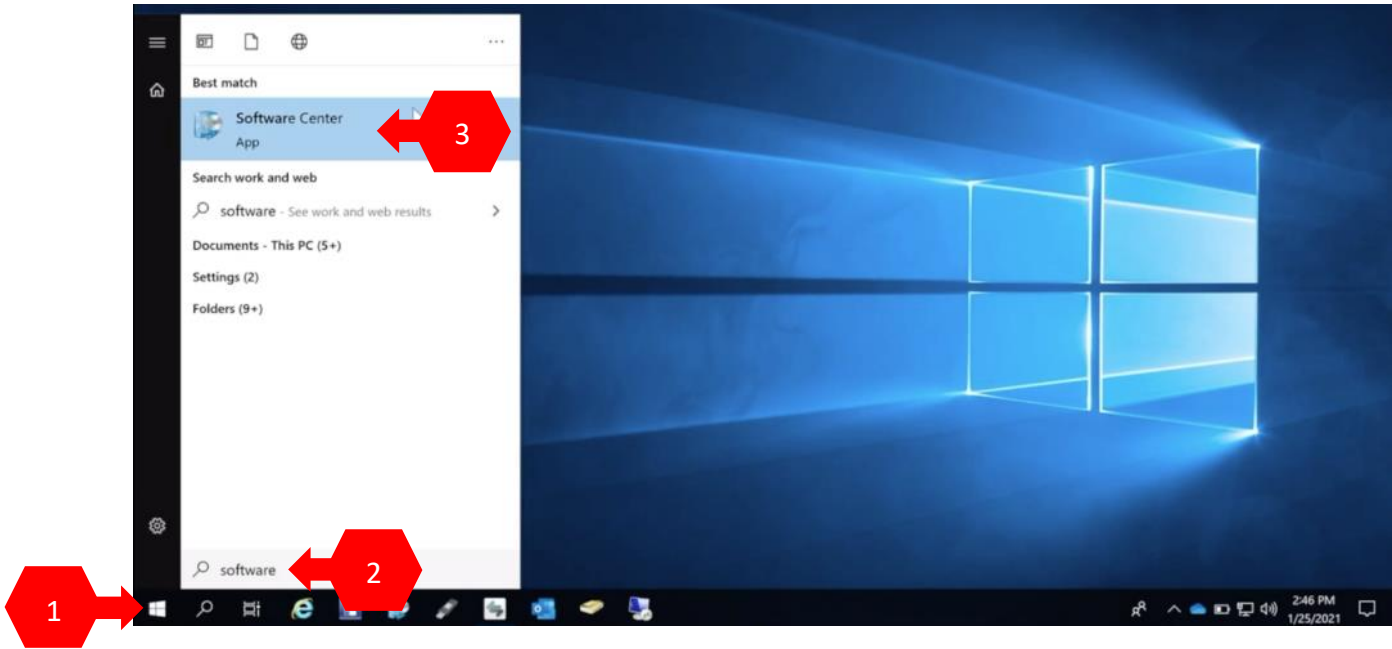
Zoom is a cloud-based video communications app that allows you to set up virtual video and audio conferencing, webinars, live chats, screen-sharing, and other collaborative capabilities. The following steps will walk you through how to install Zoom on a university-issued Windows computer.

### Installation

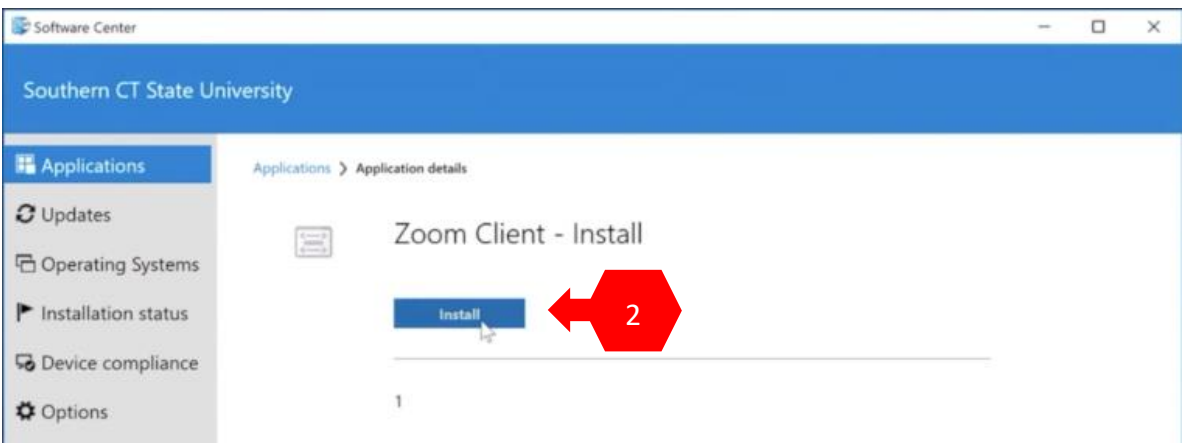
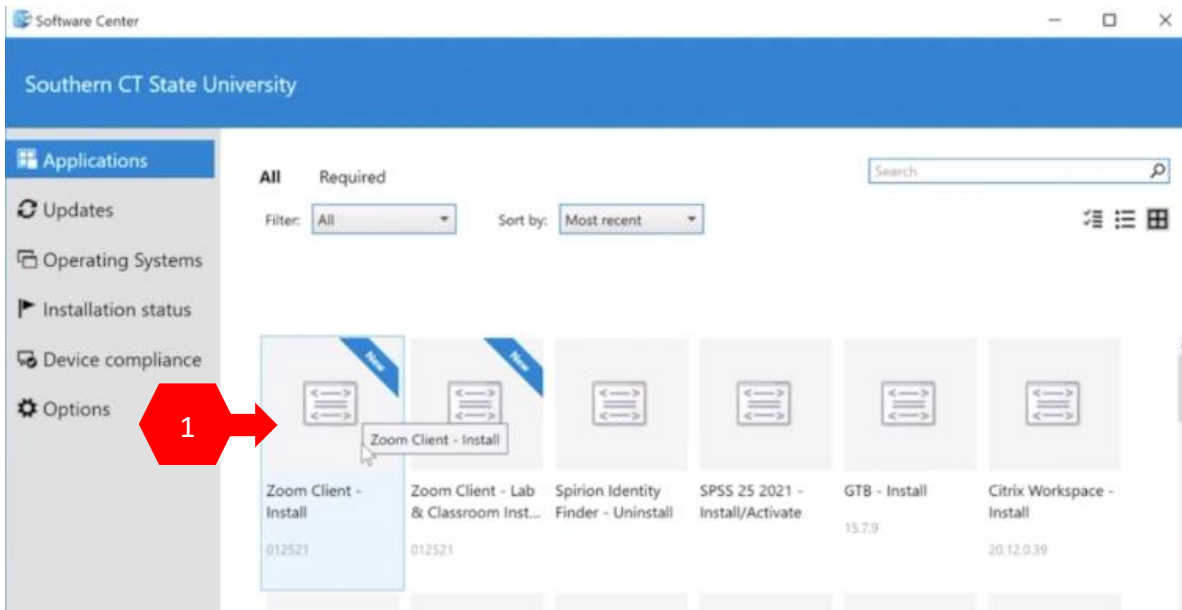
1. If working remotely, first ensure you are connected to the Global Protect VPN.



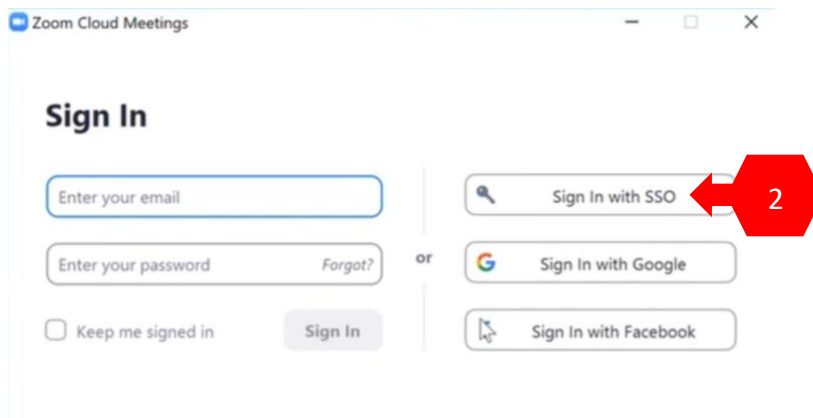
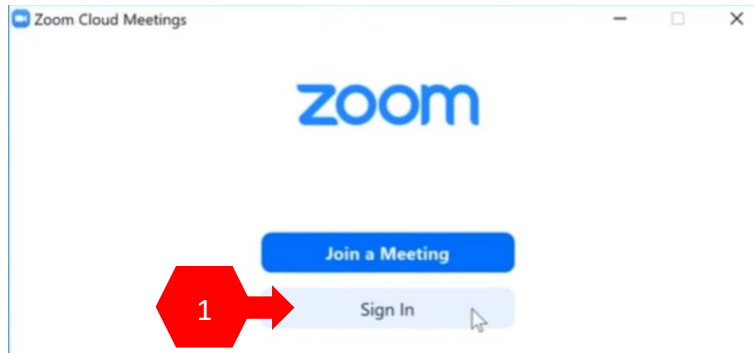
2. Open the start menu, search for "Software Center" and open.



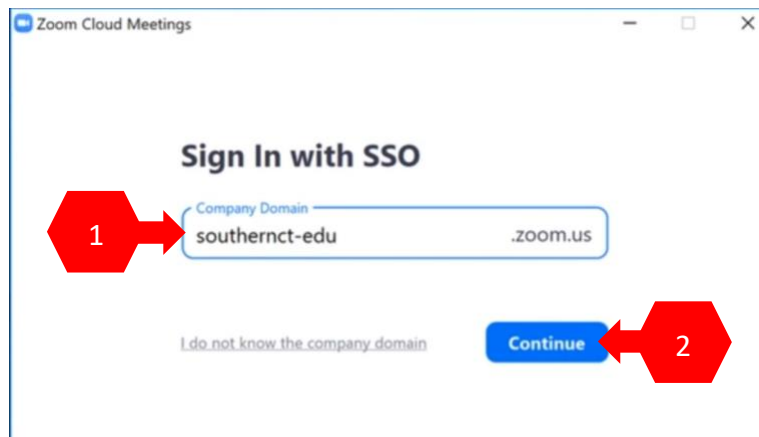
3. Select "Zoom Client – Install", then click "Install".



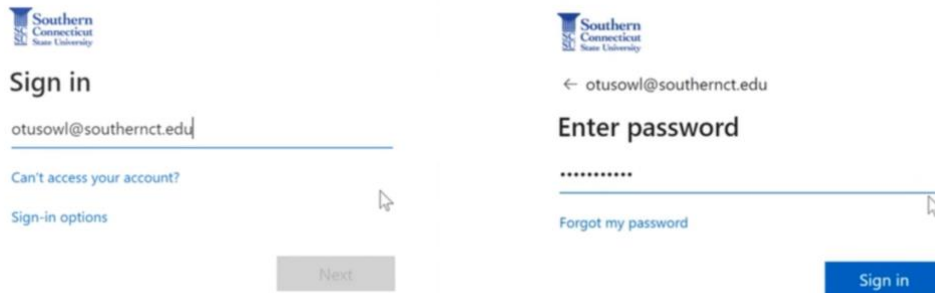
4. Zoom will launch when finished installing. Select “Sign in”, then “Sign in with SSO”.



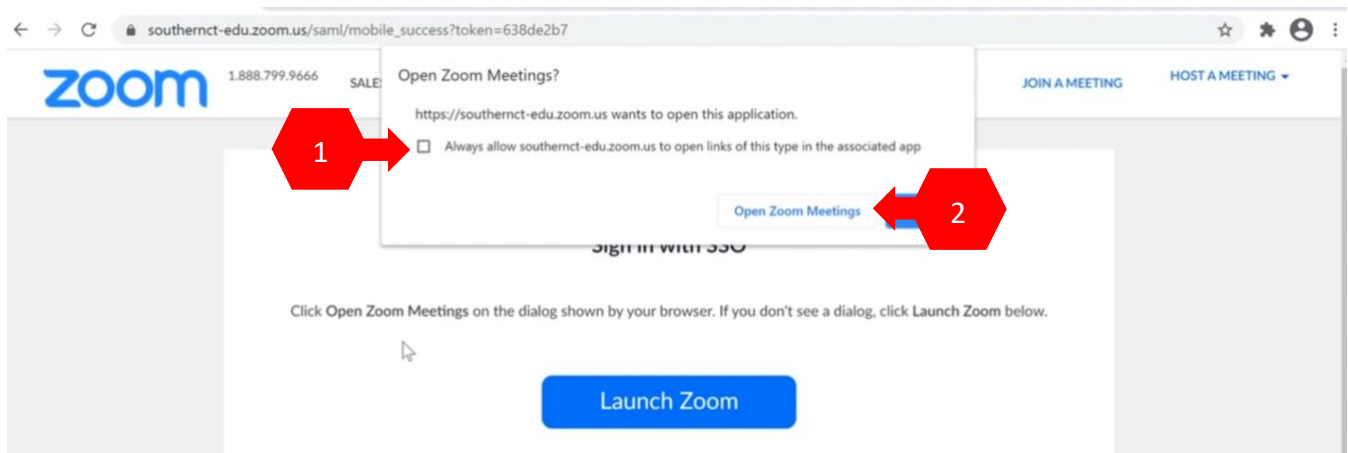
5. Enter the domain “southernct-edu” then select “Continue”.



6. Sign in using your full SCSU email address and password, and authenticate your account if prompted.



7. Follow the prompts on your browser to launch Zoom.



8. Zoom is now ready to use.
