

Policy on Battery-Powered Micro-Mobility Devices

- Definition:** Micro-Mobility Devices (MMD's) are defined to include e-scooters, e-bikes, e-skateboards, or other similar devices.
- Effective:** Immediately
- Scope:** This policy applies to all students, faculty, staff, visitors, and vendors.
- Purpose:** The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines for the use of electric scooters (e-scooters), electric bikes (e-bikes), and electric skateboards (e-skateboards) on the SCSU campus.
- This policy is designed to promote the safety, security, and well-being of all members of the university community.

Policy:

1. Prohibition of E-Scooters, E-Bikes, and E-Skateboards in university buildings:
 - 1.1. The use of MMD's is strictly prohibited in all residence halls, academic, and administrative buildings.
2. Storage:
 - 2.1. Students, Faculty, and staff who utilize an MMD on campus should lock the device on existing bike racks located throughout campus. Any MMD brought into a university building is not permitted in any classroom, hallway, or other area in which egress is impaired.
3. Enforcement:
 - 2.2. Students found in violation of this policy may be subject to disciplinary measures in accordance with the Student Code of Conduct.
 - 2.3. Faculty and staff members found in violation may be subject to appropriate administrative action.
4. Compliance:
 1. All members of the SCSU community are expected to adhere to this policy. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary actions as outlined in Section 2. 2.3. Visitors and vendors to the campus are also expected to adhere to this policy.
