

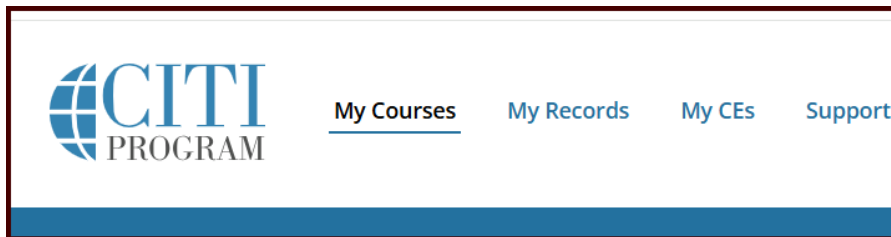
Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) Training

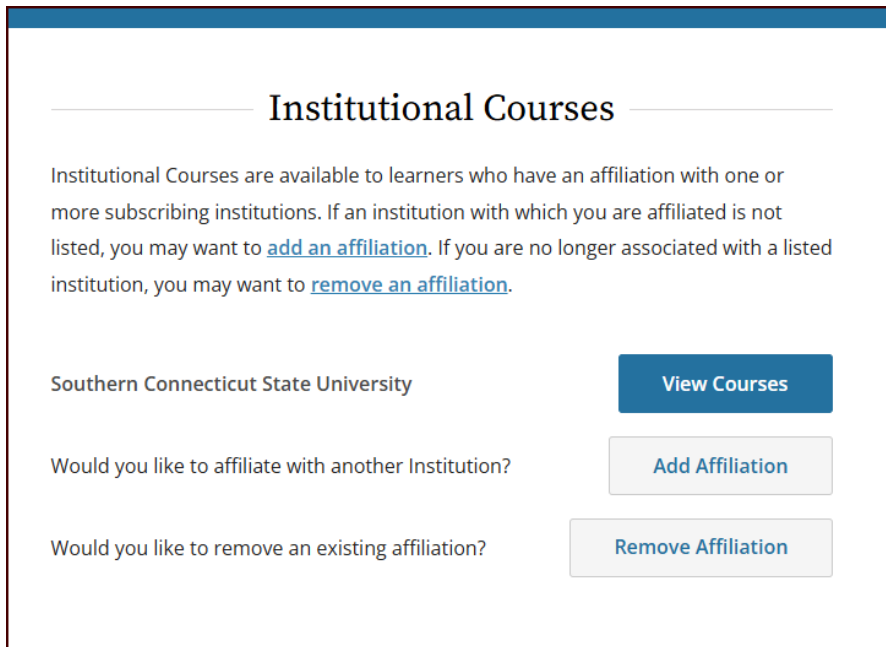
