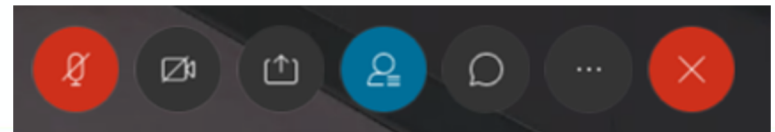

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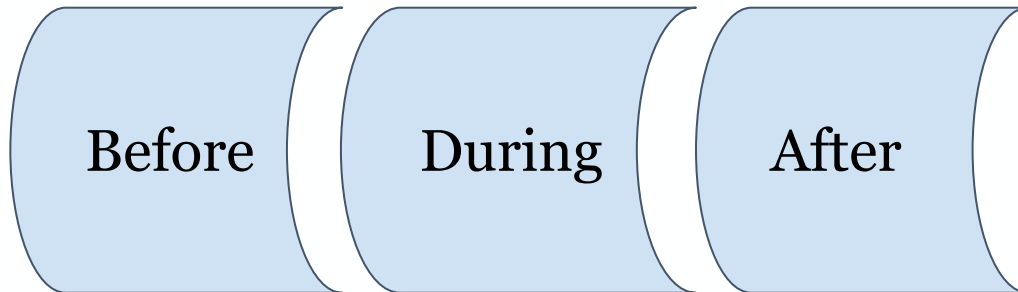
Hyflex Classroom

Teaching a hyflex class

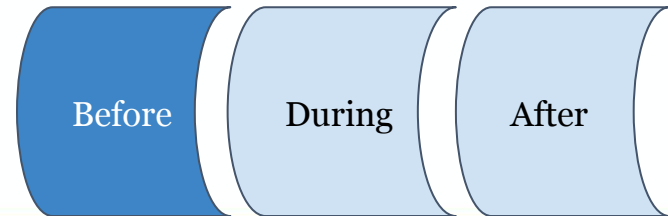


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Things to Consider

Contact students before the course begins...

- How will each student attend class?
 - If you are splitting up groups, designate groups before class or have students choose their preferred attendance
- Share tools that will be utilized for the course
- Communicate expectations



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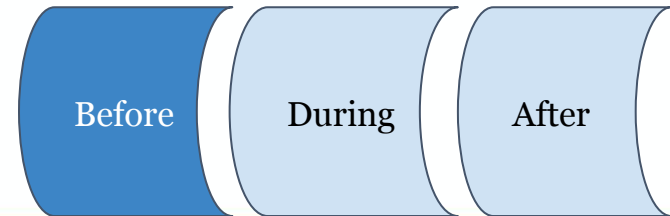
Essential Learning

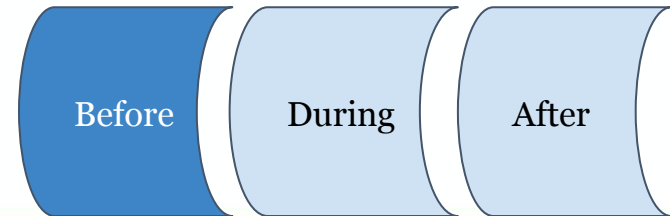

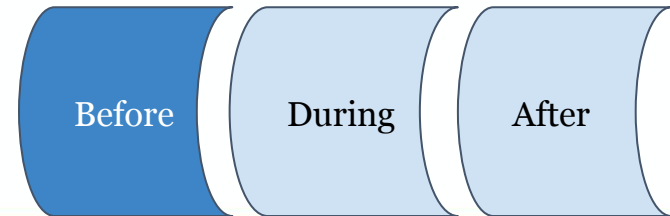

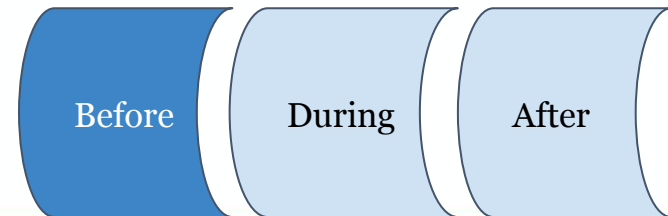
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Before

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Technical Adjustments



Before your class begins... check these settings

- Video settings → mirror view
 - So students can see what is being written on the board
- Check audio input
 - So the classroom can hear students participating virtually
- Check audio output

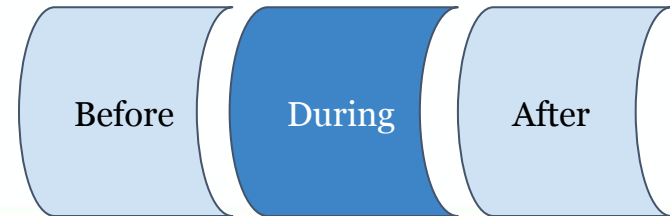
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During First Class



Review expectations for student participation (similar to what we did today)

- Participation
 - Raise hand/verbally contribute
- Technology that will be used
- Use of “chat” feature
 - Monitor occasionally
 - Ask for volunteer in-class student monitor (rotate)



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Sharing Content

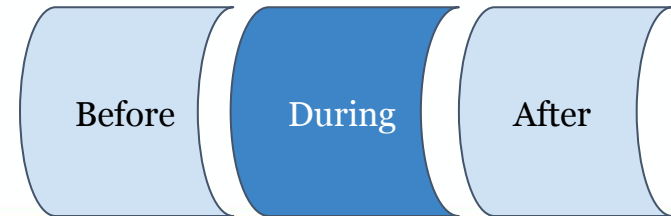


Once virtual class session has initiated, expectations are reviewed, and instruction begins...

- Share powerpoint slides/content if needed on virtual platform →

Instructor View

- If using whiteboard --> Whiteboard (Preset)
 - You can zoom/pan manually so all students can view

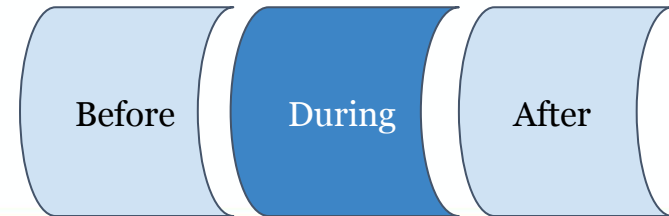


Instruction Based Ideas

- Chunk material into small portions
- Ask for practice or active learning for all students to submit to Blackboard at the end of class

Discussion Based Ideas

- Sit to include virtual students
 - “Student” view
- Engage with virtual students
- Asynchronous discussion board



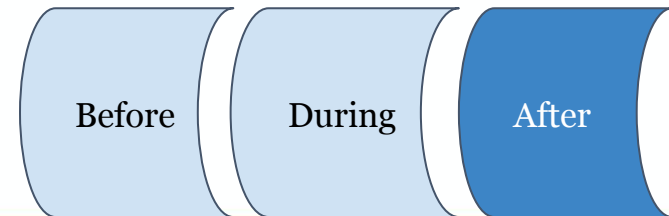
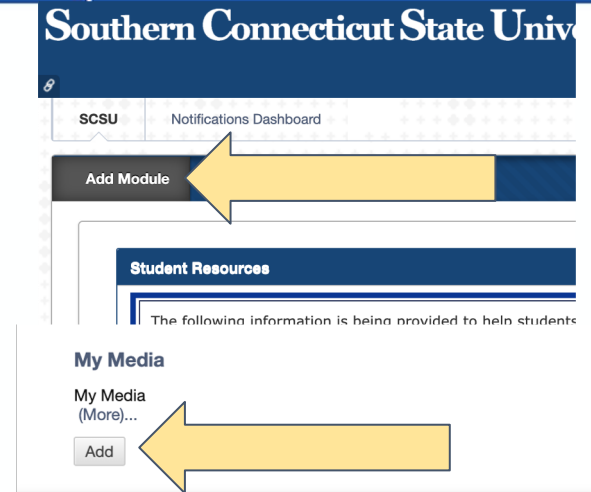
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Accessing the Recording

Hyflex classroom recordings are automatically set to record & save in Kaltura


- *If you don't want to record a portion, you need to stop the recording**

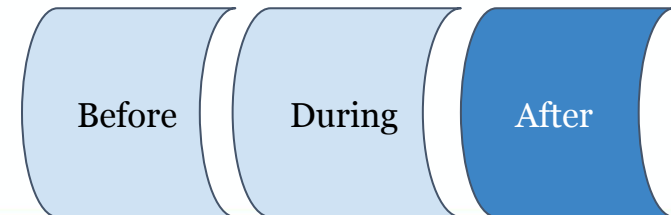
